## **POLICE TO PRESENT END OF YEAR PERFORMANCE FIGURES**

Lisburn District Policing Partnership will hold its next public meeting on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2005 in Lagan Valley Island, Lisburn at 7.00pm.

At this meeting DPP members will monitor police performance over the last twelve months and assess how effective the PSNI has been in achieving the targets set out in the local policing plan.
