What happens at a Meeting in Public?

- At the meeting the police District Commander will present the six month report on crime statistics and local policing.
- Members of the DPP will then discuss the content of the report with the District Commander.
- An opportunity is available for the public to put questions on local policing issues to the police.
- Alternatively, any member of the public may choose to ask a member of the DPP to raise an issue or ask a question on their behalf.

How can I raise an issue at the meeting?

To enable the District Commander to respond fully to a question, they should be submitted in writing, by email, fax, or by telephone to the DPP Manager no later than 11th January 2005. Your question/concern will then be forwarded to the police for the District Commander to respond to at the meeting held in public. Guidance on how to form a question is available upon request.
