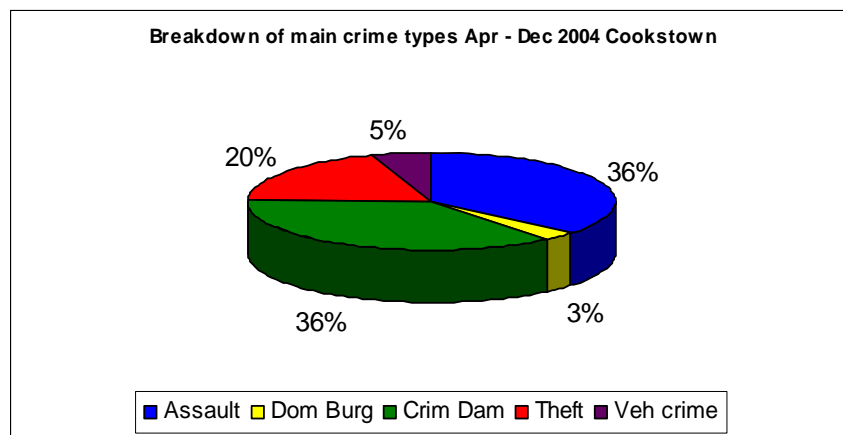
# **District Policing Partnership Brief**

Cookstown DCU April - December  
2004



- **Overall crime levels** have been reduced by 2.5% from 1472 to 1435 compared to the same period last year.
- **Overall detection rates** have decreased slightly from 43.3% (638 of 1472) to 39.7% (570 of 1435)

## DCU performance against Policing Plan crime Targets

### Domestic burglary:

This crime type has been reduced by 50% compared to the previous years figure, from 68 to 34 and also by 58.5% in line with the 2001/02 baseline figure of 82.

### Vehicle crime:

This crime type has been reduced by 23.2%, to 66 compared to the 2003/04 figure of 86 and by 47.2% compared to the 2001/02 baseline figure of 125.

### Violent crime detections:

Detection rates for Violent Crimes currently stand at 60.1%. This is 5.1% above the Service target.







### Drugs:

Seizures have decreased slightly from 48 to 42. However those charged with supply offences have doubled from 5 to 10.

### Criminal damage detections:



Detection rates for criminal damage have fallen slightly from 21.5% to 19.3% compared to the previous year.
